In the next few weeks the Bishop will hold a series of meetings as part of a process of Strategic Planning which will result in decisions about parish structures throughout Brooklyn and Queens. On February 4 a Presbyteral Assembly of all the priests of the Diocese will be held to introduce the strategic planning process and to begin to explore priestly ministry in light of such large scale institutional change; on February 6 there will be a Convocation for Professional Staff - to include deacons, pastoral associates, D.R.E.s, principals, youth ministers - all other paid pastoral leaders; on February 13, Diocesan Convocation for lay leaders - select members of Parish Pastoral Councils, Parish Finance Councils and Parish Trustees.

It is the Bishop's hope that working and praying together we can identify through the gathering of sound data the strengths of the diocese and each parish. Thus the first part of this process is an honest inventory of the church of Brooklyn and Queens and of every parish. The purpose of the process is to identify the strengths and goals and to implement the strategies that will ensure the long term vitality of the parishes. The criteria for the viability of a parish include: faith formation, vocations, demographics, leadership and the parish's material resources. Then from September 2010 to September 2011 decisions will be made by the Bishop, based on the findings of the process on what measures will need to be taken for each parish.

This process calls for all of us to practice the virtue of hope - hope in Christ who is always with the church. We do not know where this process will take us. Yet in trust guided by the Spirit we move forward building on the past so that we can continue to preach the Good News of Christ in this corner of God's Kingdom.

I will continue to keep you informed as we implement this process in the diocese, the cluster and in our parish.

When the students of St. Luke School were asked to help the relief efforts for those affected by the devastating earthquake in Haiti, they responded enthusiastically.

Each morning, our prayers were offered for the people of Haiti, in addition to prayers being said in the students' classes throughout the week. A collection basket was set up in the cafeteria throughout the week during the children's lunch period and they contributed their snack money and allowance for the people of Haiti. 


