Advent presents many figures from the Scripture for our contemplation and imitation - Isaiah, Zephaniah and the other prophets of the Old Testament; Elizabeth and Zachariah, Simeon and Anna, John the Baptist to name only a few. Yet there is no greater Advent figure worthy of our contemplation and imitation than Mary - Mother of God.

This week the church celebrates two feasts of Mary. On December 8th Mary is honored under her title of the Immaculate Conception. It is under this title that Mary is honored as patroness of our country - and of our diocese. On December 12th - Mary is honored under the title of Our Lady of Guadalupe recalling her apparition to Juan Diego in Mexico. Of special meaning to the people of Mexico, Our Lady under this title has been declared Patroness of the Americas by Pope Pius XII. Regardless of the title under which Mary is honored the church extols her faith, hope and charity. Her yes to Gabriel's message gave flesh to God's only Son whose birth we celebrate at Christmas.

Advent calls us to not only honor Mary - but to imitate her openness to do God's will. Mary's prayer must be the prayer of every Christian: "Let it be done to me as you say!" (Luke 1:26-38)

Such was the prayer of the Martyrs of El Salvador - Sisters Maura Clarke (formerly of Queens), Ita Ford (formerly of Brooklyn), Jean Donovan (lay woman whose mother went to The Mary Louis Academy) and Dorothy Kazel brutally murdered on December 2, 1980. Missionaries in El Salvador they worked especially with the poor proclaiming the Good News of Jesus. Their blood as the blood of all Christian martyrs water the seeds of faith. These martyrs are yet other Advent figures for our contemplation and imitation.

Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. God bless.


