The church possesses both water and tears: the water of baptism, the tears of penance.

St. Ambrose



In this short sentence, St. Ambrose puts well the true meaning of the Season of Lent which the church begins this coming Ash Wednesday, February 17th. Lent can only be truly understood if placed in the context of Baptism.

Lent originated in the church as a time of proximate preparation for those adults who had been preparing for initiation into Christ and the church over a number of years. After the completion of their Lenten 40 days, these people known as catechumens would be initiated at the Easter Vigil with the reception of the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist - known as the Sacraments of Initiation.

As church practice changed and the norm became the baptism of infants, Lent took on a new character and purpose. Lent now became a season for those already baptized who had fallen into sin to seek reconciliation with God and others and renewal in grace. Thus the victory of Christ over sin first brought to light in baptism is continued in the church especially in the reception of the Sacrament of Penance.

Thus the reception of Ashes expressed the human condition as affected by sin. In the sign of ashes we profess our sin before God. And more--- the cross expresses our hope in the Lord who is kind and compassionate, patient and abounding in mercy. Ashes and Cross express well our desire for inward conversion, renewal and growth in holiness. Not an impossible dream but a very possible way of life not because of our ability but by God's gracious gift - and our cooperation.

May we who begin once again this Lenten journey of 40 days keep our eyes on the joy of Easter so that renewed in mind and spirit we may share more deeply the waters of Baptism by the tears of our penance.
