On Wednesday, February 17 the church begins the holy Season of Lent. The acceptance of ashes and the tears of penance provides a special time of 40 days to reclaim our dignity as God's children which is ours through the water of Baptism. The words of John remind us of the gift of Baptism - God shares His very life with us. We are in a very real sense born again - to an eternal life - with our sins forgiven!

Lent calls us to honestly face how we have been living as a branch united to the vine the Lord Jesus. It is not all negative - only about our sins. Rather Lent is a realistic evaluation of both our strengths and weaknesses; our good and bad; our sins and our virtues.

Lent should move us to put the focus of our lives on God - who promises us great blessing. Too often I am afraid we focus not on the Lord but on our sins. Our sins must always be seen in our relationship to God who first loved us.

The parish will provide a number of opportunities for spiritual growth - Stations of the Cross; small groups scripture reflection on the Sunday Scripture (known as Disciples In Mission); Exposition and quiet adoration and prayer before the Blessed Sacrament (in addition to the usual Eucharistic Adoration on First Friday) and even a chance to once again join Fathers David and Vincent in a weekly scripture study.

Of course, all this is in addition to primary Lenten practice - the Sunday celebration of Mass. It is the Mass from which we gain the true Christian Spirit.

Listen to the words of Jesus from the parable of the Vine and the Branches:

All this I tell you that my joy may be yours and your joy may be complete.

May this Lenten Season help us to find joy in the Lord


