Today, June 13th is the feast of Saint Anthony. However, because June 13th falls on a Sunday - the Mass in honor of St. Anthony is not celebrated as every Sunday is first a feast of the Lord Jesus. However since devotion to Saint Anthony holds such a special place in the heart of so many we will include a special prayer in his honor and bless bread at the 9:00AM Italian Mass and at 11:45AM Mass.

True devotion to the saints in our Catholic tradition is meant to lead us to Christ and to a living of the Gospel. Listen to the Opening Prayer of the Mass of St. Anthony:

Almighty God, you have given St. Anthony to your people as an outstanding preacher and ready helper in time of need. with his assistance may we follow the gospel of Christ and know the help of your grace in every difficulty.

This prayer gives us the two elements of devotion to the saints: the saint as <u>intercessor</u> - who assists us by his/her prayer to God, and the saint as <u>model</u> - someone whose Christian living is worthy of our imitation. Honor and devotion to the saints is more than placing flowers in front of a statue. The acts of devotion show faith, our love for the saints and their love and assistance for us as we strive to live the Christian life. That is why St. Anthony is often represented as holding the Christ Child - St. Anthony lived and ministered to bring Christ to others.

St. Anthony is noted as a great preacher, teacher, person of prayer and lover of the poor. On this day bread is blessed and should remind us of our obligation and privilege to care for the poor and needy among us. The blessed bread is not magic, rather it is a physical reminder of what Jesus did and said at the last supper - "I give you a new commandment - love one another!" May our devotion to St. Anthony and the power of his prayers help us to put these words into practice.



Strengthen our resolve to continue to bring about your reign in our world, through the efforts of all: our bishops, priests, deacons, women and men religious, and parishioners.


