Today is the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Although the church celebrates the institution of the Eucharist at the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, a special feast of the Body and Blood or Christ again offers us the opportunity to reflect on the mystery of Christ's presence in the Blessed Sacrament.

On this feast, therefore, the church once again urges us to reflect on the Eucharist so that we may celebrate "the wonderful works of God signified by the sacrament and accomplished by the paschal mystery of Christ." (Ceremonial of Bishop #385). This solemnity also urges us to share more fully in the Eucharistic sacrifice and most importantly to allow the Eucharist to profoundly influence our lives.

All are invited to join in the Procession of the Blessed Sacrament which will follow the 5:00pm Mass today - Sunday, June 26. Let us give witness to our belief in the Eucharist as the Blessed Sacrament is carried solemnly and with prayers and singing through the streets of Whitestone. Plan to join in this special devotion associated with the feast of Corpus Christi.

I am pleased to announce that our Parish Carnival made a profit of approximately \$35,000. Again a sincere thank you to all our volunteers, committee chairs and two general co-chairs - Sal Colak and Sabato Daniele for all their hard work and generosity of time and talent in making the Carnival a success in so many ways.

The funds raised will be shared with both the school and parish: \$25,000 will be given to the school to be used toward creation of a new school playground. This will be added to the \$55,000 already designated for the playground from the 100th Anniversary Gala; \$10,000 will be given to the parish to be used for the restoration of the stained glass windows in the church.

A Volunteer Thank You Party is now being planned for the fall of 2011 sometime around the feast of Saint Luke in October. This will give me the opportunity to personally thank each of you.



Their mission is to spread devotion to Our Lady and to tell people the power of praying the rosary. We welcomed her by doing just that at 10 am about a hundred of us gathered together to pray the rosary with the image. One of the priests from Pompeii shared with us why it is so important to pray the rosary. He said that "the rosary is not just Marian but it is also Christological," that is centers around the life of Christ. Throughout the day I witnessed people come in to our church to visit the image of Our Lady. They came from all over Whitestone, the Bronx, Manhattan, Connecticut, and Westchester.
