

FROM THE PRINCIPAL ----

As we approach the beginning of a new school year, I would like to take this opportunity to welcome all of you. For many, it is a greeting extended to old friends; to others, it is an introduction and an invitation. To all, it constitutes a pledge of continued efforts to provide the best possible education for our children.

Our summer has been busy with preparations for the 2009-2010 school year. Thanks to the generosity of Mr. Robert McDonagh, one of our school families and the owner of RMD Floors, we were able to remove the rugs in three more classrooms and refinish the beautiful wood floors that were hidden underneath. Our hallways were given a fresh coat of paint and five classrooms were also repainted (two of which were painted by the teachers themselves!). All of the rugs have been shampooed and a thorough cleaning of the school was done by our cleaning crew.

New to St. Luke's this year, and as a result of requests from parents, is a five day Nursery School Program, in addition to our three day program. We are very happy to be able to offer this class, as it will provide more "school" time for our very curious three year old children. This program is a direct offshoot of the successful Tiny Tots Program which began last year for our two year olds. It is very gratifying to all of us here to see our school continue to grow and prosper.

Our most exciting addition to the school is the acquisition of SmartBoards for all of our classrooms. St. Luke School was chosen to receive a \$50,000 technology grant, called Project Excel, from the Brooklyn Diocese in order to provide state of the art instructional technology to our students. Our faculty has already attended classes to learn the basics of SmartBoard technology and will continue to receive professional development throughout the year.

We have also begun planning in earnest for St. Luke School's 100th Anniversary celebration, as you can see by our new school logo above. It is hard to believe that our school began in 1910 under the direction of two Dominican Sisters and one lay teacher in the basement of the church. So many years have passed, so many children have walked these halls, and we are still successfully educating our young people. We are extremely proud of our Catholic tradition and academic excellence in a community grounded in common faith and we are looking forward to celebrating this wonderful occasion with all of you.

Enjoy the remaining summer days. Please keep us in your prayers as we continue to prepare to open our doors for what will be a wonderful year for our children.

As a community of believers in Jesus Christ and in communion with the universal church, we strive to follow the Lord's command to love God and one another. Rooted in word and sacrament, we grow together as a Eucharistic community inviting all to the Good News of Jesus.


This process or faith journey begins with a period of inquiry. We invite you to come and explore!

Having reached the parish goal of \$93,701 all gifts over goal come directly back to the parish. This depends on each of us fulfilling our promised gift.



YOUTH CHOIR AUDITIONS

If your child wishes to join the Youth Choir, we will be hearing children sing before the first rehearsal on September 22 at 3:00pm. These auditions will take place in the Music Room which is accessible at the rear of the church. We welcome children from the public schools as well as our parochial schools.

Your child must be in the 3rd Grade or above, and their reading level must be up to the grade they are presently in. It is important that you tell your children that singing in the choir is a commitment and they must attend all rehearsals and performances.

Besides singing for the Family Mass on the 3rd Sunday of each month, the choir will learn the rudiments of music theory, vocal technique and choral etiquette. They will also be participating in other events during the course of the Liturgical Year including Lessons & Carols and services during Holy Week.

Rehearsals will begin Tuesday, September 22. Each rehearsal begins promptly at 3:30pm and ends at 4:30pm. Please be sure that your child is here by 3:20pm so we may begin rehearsal as scheduled.
