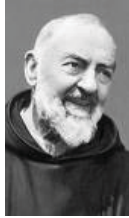
MISSION STATEMENT

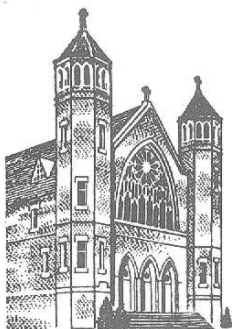

Dear Parishioners,

In the fall of 2009, our parish conducted the Diocesan sponsored *Parish Support Program (PSP)*, designed to enhance the offertory collection of the parish. The PSP proved to be a great success. I can truly say it has had a positive effect on the parish's financial well-being. The participation and generosity of hundreds of parishioners during the program was certainly instrumental to our success. I would like to personally thank all the parish households who responded to the call for greater giving. I am deeply grateful for the continuous support you have provided your parish.

Please understand that this letter is not another formal request for increased financial contributions. It is simply a thank you and a gentle reminder to ask that you please continue your weekly support as you indicated on the Commitment Form you returned during the program. Now, I understand that not every family was able to make an increased commitment last year, I ask that you prayerfully reflect upon your current level of giving and consider an increase as your means will allow this year. Before we know it the winter months will be upon us, and your support will be particularly important when fuel costs are higher.

The goal of the program was to strengthen our parish by increasing the number of registered parishioners, and increase our weekly collections by 20%, this meant an additional \$2-\$4 each week for most families. For the upcoming months ahead I ask that you please remember Saint Luke each and every week and continue to return your envelopes on a regular basis. Your consistent support to the weekly collection helps us better project our budget and prioritize our goals in the future and meet parish obligations.

Youth Choir Auditions

If your child wishes to join the youth choir, we will be hearing children sing before the first rehearsal on September 28 at 3:00. These auditions will take place in the Music Room which is accessible at the rear of the church. We welcome children from the public schools as well as our parochial schools.

Your child must be in the 3rd Grade or above, and their reading level must be up to the grade they are presently in. It is important that they understand that singing in the choir is a commitment and that they must attend all rehearsals and performances.

Besides singing for the Family Mass on the 3rd Sunday of each month, the choir will learn the rudiments of music theory, vocal technique & choral etiquette. They will also be participating in other events during the course of the Liturgical Year including Lessons & Carols and services during Holy Week.

Rehearsals will begin Tuesday, September 28. Each rehearsal begins promptly at 3:30 p.m. and ends at 4:30 p.m. Please be sure that your child is here by 3:20 p.m. so we may begin rehearsal as scheduled.

PRE-JORDAN PROGRAM

Our baptismal program anticipates the needs of the couple before or after the birth of their child. It continues to offer support and concern at the at the baptismal visit, class and ceremony.

If you are planning to baptize a child here at St. Luke's here is some information you need to know.

Six weeks before the Pre-Jordan class, please pick up at the rectory the baptismal packet. Fill out the information and return it with a copy of the birth certificate. The diocese requires that we see the birth certificate before the Baptism can take place. We cannot issue a baptismal certificate unless we have seen the birth certificate. When we have received this information Sister Catherine Reilly, O.P. will contact you to prepare you for the baptismal visit (for the first child), the class and the ceremony.

The Pre-Jordan classes are held on the third Monday of the month at 7:30pm-9:00pm in the church basement. In January and February they are held on the second Monday. The Baptism ceremony is generally held on the second and fourth Sunday of the month at 3:00pm. Please do not make any reception plans without checking the Baptism dates and completing all the necessary requirements.

Every year we baptize about 130 children. We ask that you do not request a private baptism unless there is a valid reason for one.
