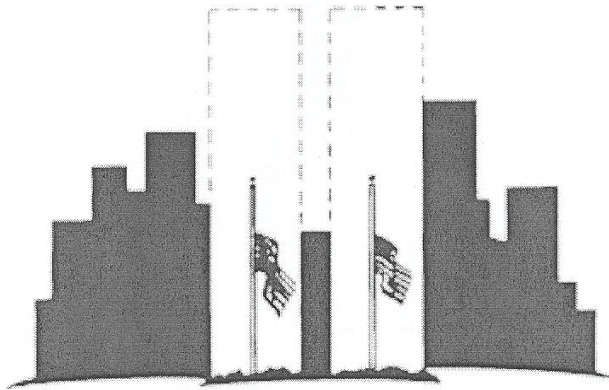

TENTH ANNIVERSARY OF 9/11

As the city and nation prepare to observe the 10th Anniversary of the terrorist attacks that took the lives of so many in New York, Washington, D.C. and Shanksville, Pennsylvania the parish will observe this terrible day united in prayer in two special ceremonies:

Ecumenical Prayer Service hosted by Saint Luke on Saturday, September 10th at 7:00pm will bring together various Whitestone churches to pray for those who died, their families and for peace, especially an end to all forms of violence and terrorism. Special Mass of Remembrance on Sunday September 11, 2011 at 11:45am. Join those families in the parish who lost loved ones on that terrible day in praying for the deceased as we seek the gift of peace and healing for their families and loved ones. A visit to the September 11 Memorial in front of the school with the placement of a Memorial Wreath donated by the Knights of Columbus will follow the Mass. Refreshments in the lower church.

Words from Bishop DiMarzio:

...On Sunday, September 11, 2011 our city and nation will observe the tenth anniversary of the terrorist attacks that took the lives of thousands of our brothers and sisters in New York, Washington, D.C. and Shanksville, Pennsylvania. Since that terrible day, we have been united in prayer for an end to all terrorism, extremism of any kind and violence throughout the world. This September 11th will provide a unique occasion for the entire Church to pray for the repose of all those who died, both on that terrible day and in the ensuing years through illness contracted from exposure to Ground Zero. We must also redouble our prayers for a just and lasting peace throughout the world.

La prego di rendersi interprete di questi nostri affettuosi sentimenti presso quanti con zelo hanno collaborato al nostro apostolato.

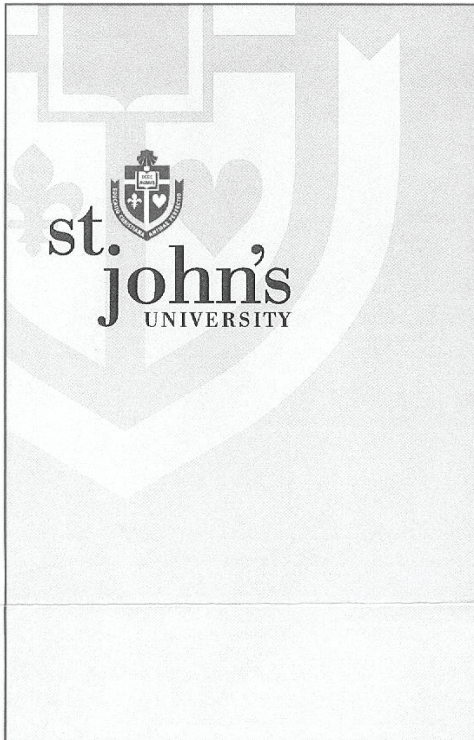
