FROM THE DESK OF MSGR. TOSI ---

Christians, praise the paschal victim! Offer thankful sacrifice! Christ the lamb has saved the sheep, Christ the just one paid the price, Reconciling sinners to the Father.

Death and life fought bitterly for this wondrous victory;

The Lord of life who died reigns glorified!

O Mary, come and say what you saw at break of day.

"The empty tomb of my living Lord! I saw Christ Jesus risen and adored!

"Bright angels testified, shroud and grave clothes side by side!

"Yes, Christ my hope rose gloriously. He goes before you into Galilee."

Share the good news, sing joyfully: His death is victory!

Lord Jesus, victor King, show us mercy. Amen.

Easter sequence - Roman rite - Eleventh century

I can only describe the Easter celebration here at the parish as truly awesome. Throughout Holy Week the sacred liturgy was well celebrated by ministers and congregation alike. Holy Week, the Easter Triduum and Easter are always times of special grace and blessings. This year was no exception. As pastor I am so grateful for the ability to share these sacred days with you. And so many of you! My heart rejoiced to see so many parishioners alive in faith - rejoicing in the gift of new life in Christ's Paschal Mystery. I am so blessed when I see your reverence and active participation in the church liturgy. Once again, I am humbled by your love of God, of one another - and of me.

The tomb is empty; Christ is Risen. Christ has saved the sheep; His death is victory. Alleluia, alleluia.

And yet the mystery of Christ's Death and Resurrection is celebrated every Sunday. As St. Justin writes:

It is on Sunday that we all assemble, because Sunday is the first day: the day on which God transformed darkness and matter and created the world, and the day on which Jesus Christ our Savior rose from the dead. He was crucified on the eve of Saturn's day, and on the day after, that is, on the day of the sun, he appeared to his apostles and disciples and taught them what we have now offered for your examination.

So many came at Easter while our Lord waits each Sunday to fill us with His love and mercy. If only we understand the wonder of God's love for us. The challenge for us is to reach out to those who filled the church on Easter Day. Easter can be bittersweet. We pray that all be open to the gift of salvation in Christ.

I again wish to thank all those who shared time, talents and treasure in creating the beauty and prayerfulness of the solemn liturgies. To the liturgical ministers, music ministers, sacristans, ushers, scouts, altar servers - and to all of you a most sincere thank you. As good stewards you became instruments of God's manifold graces and blessings. God bless.




